How to Apply a Topspot Application to Your Pet

- ❖ Ensure that you have the correct product and dose for your pet's weight range. Also ensure that it is for the correct species as some dog products are toxic when applied to cats. You may need to enlist the help of someone else to restrain them.
- ❖ Remove a single application from the box. To open, either push the cap down to pierce the tube or snap the top of the pipette to open. A clicking sound indicates the cap or seal has been broken.
- ❖ Pick a spot somewhere between the back of the head and the shoulder blades of the animal. The goal is to place the liquid where the animal cannot lick it off. It may be placed in one spot or several but do not move from that area. Ensure all of the medication within the pipette is used.
- ❖ Part the fur so you can see the skin and squeeze the contents of the tube directly onto the skin. For cats and small dogs this usually only requires one spot, but for larger dogs you may need to place it in several spots.
- ❖ Wash your hands if you come into contact with any of the medication.



- ❖ Let them go and your job is done! There may be a wet or greasy spot on their fur where you applied the treatment for the next day or so. This is normal and no cause for concern.
